## ABC NATURE WALK

Here is a fun activity to do with any group of children (or adults). Encourage children to use their imagination. For example, an answer for " X " might be, "eXtremely small insect." Using clipboards will make the activity much easier!

- Compare results. Create a tally or chart for duplicate answers.
- Discuss: which letters were the easiest? Which were the most challenging?
- Try in pairs or small groups (probably without sketching).
- Try the same activity in two very different places. For example, at the beach and in a forest.
