Here is a fun activity to do with any group of children (or adults). Encourage children to use their imagination. For example, an answer for "X" might be, "eXtremely small insect." Using clipboards will make the activity much easier!

Extend the activity:

- Compare results. Create a tally or chart for duplicate answers.
- Discuss: which letters were the easiest? Which were the most challenging?
- Try in pairs or small groups (probably without sketching).
- Try the same activity in two very different places. For example, at the beach and in a forest.
